You MUST bring your USA Hockey registration confirmation when you register for any of our programs. Current registrations are good through August 31st and will have to be renewed prior to registering for the 2010-2011 season.

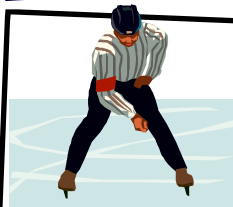
